Gastroenterology deals with diseases of the digestive system, including gallbladder, bile ducts, liver, and pancreas. Some of our specialist physicians also specialize in respiratory disorders.

They offer tests such as pulmonary function testing, blood gas analysis, and respiration monitoring during the night, among others. With this wide spectrum of services we provide complete basic care for the whole region.

Treatment spectrum

Pulmonology

- » Pulmonary function test including spirometry and cardiopulmonary exercise testing
- » Chest sonography
- » Blood gas analysis, body plethysmography, and diffusing capacity determination for COPD, asthma, and interstitial lung disease (staging)
- » Insertion of chest drains
- » Non-invasive ventilation therapy for respiratory and pulmonary diseases
- » Sleep laboratory (polysomnography)
- » Intensive care with invasive or non-invasive mechanical ventilation
- » Preparation for home ventilation and long-term oxygen therapy
- » Chest and transesophageal echocardiography
- » Tracheotomy (endoscopic and open) for long-term mechanical ventilation



Treatment spectrum

Cardiology

- » Resting ECG, exercise ECG, and Holter ECG, 6-minute walk test
- » Laboratory tests for cardiac disorders
- » Cycle- or treadmill-based cardiopulmonary exercise testing with blood gas analysis and lactate determination
- » Echocardiography, stress echocardiography, strain analysis
- » Transesophageal echocardiography
- » Pacemaker and ICD follow-up
- » Ambulatory blood pressure monitoring
- » Holter ECG
- » Polygraphy for hypertension and heart failure of unknown origin
- » Duplex sonography of the vascular system
- » Pacemaker implantation
- » Therapeutic drainage
- » Counseling regarding cardiovascular disease prevention and smoking cessation
- » Cholesterol lowering counseling
- » Diagnosis and counseling for Lyme disease, myocarditis, pulmonary embolism, CABG, mitral valve prolapse, pericarditis and hypertension



Treatment spectrum

Endoscopy

- » Endoscopy of esophagus, stomach, duodenum
- » Endoscopy of the large bowel
- » Interventions in the upper and lower gastrointestinal tract
- » Sonography of all abdominal organs, vascular system, and thyroid using state-of-the-art technology
- » Food intolerance testing
